- Pie crusts and fillings must be **made from scratch**.
- Pies that require refrigeration **cannot be entered** (cream fillings, meringues, custards, home canned fillings, pumpkin, etc.)
- No cream cheese or dairy toppings.
- We do not accept nut pies.
- There will be one prize awarded in each category. Each entrant will select the category for their pie(s) upon registration. An individual may enter as many times as they want.
- Pies are scored on appearance, crust, and overall taste/flavor.
